CONDITIONS OF ENTRY, SALE AND PURCHASE

1. The following conditions apply to all vehicles entered for sale and sold by Hopauctions.com (referred to hereafter as 'the Auctioneers').
2. Vehicles will only be accepted for sale when an entry form has been completed, the correct entry fee has been paid and the registration book and valid test certificate (if applicable) has been handed to the Auctioneers. The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse to offer a vehicle for sale.
3. Selling commission on the price for which the vehicle is sold shall be in accordance with the published charges. Charges are displayed in the auction office. Such commission shall be payable by the Vendor at the time of sale whether by auction or by private treaty.
4. Vehicles will be sold without reserve unless a reserve price is clearly stated in the appropriate space on the entry form.
5. Vehicles left on the Auctioneers premises is done so at the owners risk. Vendors should have the appropriate insurance where applicable. Under no circumstances do the Auctioneers accept responsibility for loss or damage regardless of cause.
6. On the sale of any vehicle the contract of sale shall be deemed to be one solely between the Vendor and the Purchaser. Neither the Vendor nor the Purchaser shall have any legal right of action against the Auctioneer in respect of any cause or matter arising out of the sale unless such matter is the result of the Auctioneers error or negligence.
7. All particulars supplied on the entry form and the descriptions contained therein form the basis of the contract between the Vendor and the Auctioneers. Under no circumstances will the Auctioneers be responsible nor will any allowance be made to Purchasers should there be any error or misdescription in any lot. Accuracy and correctness of statements made are the entire responsibility of the Vendor.
8. The Purchaser should inspect any vehicle purchased by him before purchase. All vehicles are sold without warranty and the Purchaser shall have no right of complaint regarding damage, mechanical condition, fitness for purpose or roadworthiness. The Purchasers right to take action against the Vendor beyond these periods is unaffected.
9. The highest bidder will be deemed to be the Purchaser subject to meeting the Vendor's reserve (if any) and subject to the Auctioneers right to refuse the bidding of any person. Should any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot in dispute may be put up for sale again at the last undisputed bid at the discretion of the Auctioneers. Vendors reserve the right to bid. The Auctioneers decision is final and binding on both Vendor and Purchaser.
10. On completion of a sale the Purchaser is required to give the Auctioneer their full name and address and pay for the lot in full, or at the discretion of the Auctioneer, pay a deposit. Balances must be paid off in full before any vehicle can be removed.
11. The Auctioneers reserve the right to sell any vehicle which has failed to sell by auction by Private Treaty at the reserve price or such other price agreed by the Vendor. In this instance, in accordance with condition 3 sales commission shall be paid to the Auctioneers by the Vendor.
12. In the event of a vehicle being sold without a valid test certificate or does not comply with the Road Traffic Acts the Purchaser shall not remove it from the Auctioneers premises under its own power. Every vehicle sold without the appropriate certificate is sold on the understanding that it will not be used on a road within the UK until it complies with the appropriate laws and regulations. Nothing contained within this condition shall authorise the Purchaser to allow the vehicle to remain at the place of auction.
13. The Purchaser is required to pay in addition to the purchase price a service charge when the vehicle is paid for. The Auctioneers will indemnify the Purchaser against claims and payments for which the Purchaser may be liable arising from and in the event that the Vendor does not have full legal ownership of the vehicle at the time of the sale.
14. Vehicles shall be at the risk of the Purchaser from the fall of the hammer and shall be taken away at the Purchasers expense and risk between the times named by the Auctioneers at the time of the sale. No vehicle will be released until paid in full and where more than one lot is purchased payment for all items must be made in full before they can be removed.
15. The Vendor will have no right to payment for any item until the Auctioneers have received full payment from the Purchaser.
16. Cheques will not be accepted from Purchasers unknown to the auctioneer and may be declined as an instrument of payment without reason. No cash will be taken on the day of Auction.
18. All vehicles whether sold or unsold must be removed from the Auctioneers premises within 7 days of the auction.
17. Failure to comply with any one or more of the above conditions will result in the forfeit of any monies deposited.
18. Monies received on behalf of clients are deposited in a non-interest bearing client account maintained at Nat-West bank, Barnsley.
19. The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse to accept for sale any vehicle if they consider the reserve price to be unreasonable.
20. Terms:
 - a) 'Auctioneer' or 'Auctioneers' means Hopauctions.com Ltd.
 - b) 'Vendor' includes the owner of the vehicle, his authorised agent and any other person offering the vehicle or equipment for sale whether authorised by the owner or not.
 - c) 'Purchaser' shall include the highest bidder, the person declared as being the Purchaser by the Auctioneer or the person to whom the vehicle has been sold by private treaty.
 - d) 'Vehicle' shall include all motor vehicles, trailers, machinery and items of plant entered for sale, whether by Public Auction or Private Treaty.
